About Christenings

Having your child Christened is something that we celebrate and welcome at both our churches. A Christening is when we come together to celebrate and give thanks for your child being born in this world and we pray for their future and the future of their family. It is a beautiful event and your child will be welcomed into the church as a child of God. There are many different reasons that parents decide to christen their babies and we understand that faith comes in all different shapes, sizes and expressions!

On one level the Christening is a moment when we will ask God to bless and know your child, to guide and love your child, and to help your child to make all the good choices in life, choose the paths that lead to blessedness. We talk a lot about light and dark, sin and goodness, cleansing because these are all metaphors for the choices and struggles that human life often presents us with. We believe that your child receives the light of Christ (God's love) in his/her baptism and with that an invitation to see how faith and prayer can help them in the years to follow.

On another level, a Christening is when the door and heart of the church is opened for your child/ren – and indeed for you all as a family. Please know that you are all invited and welcomed. The Church door remains open for rest of their life to explore what the Christian faith means, maybe to learn to pray, maybe to rely on God in good times and bad, and to learn more about the finest example of love human beings have known – the person of Jesus Christ.
